

## Is This Credential Right for Me?

### ***Project Management Professional***

If you answer “yes” to all of the questions below PMI recommends that you pursue the PMP® credential.

1. Do you have a Bachelor’s degree or the global equivalent *and* 36 months of professional project management experience? If not, do you have a High School diploma, Associate’s degree or the global equivalent, *and* 60 months of professional project management experience?
2. Have you had at least 35 contact hours of formal project management education (e.g., courses or programs offered by PMI, universities or colleges, employer or company, distance-learning providers or training companies)?
3. Do you perform your duties under general supervision?
4. Are you responsible for all aspects of a project or for the life of the project?
5. Do you lead and direct cross-functional teams to deliver projects within the constraints of schedule, budget and scope?
6. Do you demonstrate sufficient knowledge and experience to appropriately apply a methodology to projects that have reasonably well-defined requirements and deliverables?
7. Are you familiar with *A Guide to the Project Management Body of Knowledge (PMBOK® Guide)*?
